## NOTICE

Subject: Segregation of Dry, Wet and Hazardous waste by the residents in terms of the Guidelines/Directives of the Municipal Corporation of Gurugram.

Municipal Corporation of Gurugram notice dated 24.9.2020 had been served upon our Society inviting attention to the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 of the State that mandate for the Waste Generators the segregation of waste into three streams, i.e., Wet Waste, Dry Waste and Domestic Hazardous/Biomedical Waste. As per the notice, our Society which falls into the category of "Bulk Waste Generators" is required to make arrangements for the setting up of the composting units and not to throw, bury or burn the solid waste generated in the Society. The MCG has notified a list of vendors for assistance in this regard and we have since engaged one such vendor, namely, M/s Gogreen Facility Services. This vendor is at present collecting the domestic waste from the apartments, segregating and disposing it in terms of the MCG norms/guidelines. The notice warns of heavy penalties in case any Bulk Waste Generator that fails to comply with the prescribed guidelines.

- 2. The EC at its meeting held on 11.4.2021 considered the matter and it was inter alia decided to commence the work of segregation of domestic waste at the point of its origin, i.e., at the apartment level in the right earnest in order to streamline its disposal.
- 3. The waste will be picked up from the apartments as per the present practice. The only change is that the residents shall henceforth segregate their waste into three categories, i.e., Wet Waste, Dry Waste and Hazardous/Biomedical Waste before the same is collected for disposal. The Wet Waste may be put in Black/Green Bag, Dry Waste in White/Blue Bag and the Hazardous/Biomedical Waste in Yellow coloured Bag. The Colour indication of the bags is meant for ease of distinction/identification.
- 4. The residents of the MS apartments may drop their Wet Waste in the chute as usual, whereas the other two categories of waste be kept in the cabin of the chute at the respective floor from where it will be get collected by the vender.
- 5. Residents are requested to strictly comply with these requirements as mandated by the MCG to enable the Society in turn to comply with its statutory obligations.
